


Bangkok Gems & Jewelry Fair 72nd Edition Hits New Records with Nearly 4.7 Billion THB in Trade Value



The Department of International Trade Promotion (DITP), in collaboration with the Gem and Jewelry Institute of Thailand (Public Organization) - GIT proudly announced the resounding success of the 72nd Bangkok Gems & Jewelry Fair (BGJF), held from 9-13 September 2025 at the Queen Sirikit National Convention Center (QSNCC). The fair recorded an unprecedented trade value of 4.7 billion THB, representing a 26% increase from the previous edition. Over

the five-day event, the fair welcomed more than 46,000 trade visitors from around the world, reaffirming its position as one of the most influential gatherings in the global gems and jewelry industry.



With 1,106 exhibitors occupying 2,628 booths, the fair offered a diverse showcase spanning gemstones, diamonds, gold, silver, pearls, fine jewelry, machinery, and packaging solutions. This strong turnout from both exhibitors and visitors reflects not only the dynamism of Thailand's jewelry sector but also the fair's role as a premier international trading platform that bridges heritage, innovation, and global opportunity.
